Dear all,

you have contributed to the FP7 vision paper on displays and large area electronics. We want to inform you about an important follow-up:

in Brussels.**

**For clarification: this is a consultation in addition to the input that has been given to the Photonics21 Platform.**

Although displays are part of the "lighting and displays" workgroup of Photonics21 -- we have fed the vision paper into their process -- there are still topics in our area of interest not covered by Photonics21. Photonics21 representatives will report on what has been settled in their group. This gives the chance of sorting out which topics should be fed into the FP7 process from this meeting.

**This can be seen as the last chance for input to the 7th framework programme before the workprogrammes will be written and approved.**

To be most effective in our discussion, we should utilize the results of the work previously done:

- \* the vision paper (19.05.2005)
- \* the research topics that were collected as an attachment to the vision paper (19.05.2005)
- \* the outcome of the consultation meeting on 10.06.2005 (prioritisation of research topics -- see attached table),
- \* the results of the discussions we had at the organic cluster brainstorming on 14.02.2006 and
- \* the outcome of the discussions we had during the adria advisory board meeting on 22.02.2006.

This way we can deliver a complete picture of the needs of our community for FP7.

To be most effective, I will propose to the Commission

\* to target a format for "a handful" of research topics that **already suit the workprogramme format** (see example attached, pages 4ff):

- 1 headline
- objective
- 2-5 focus areas

\* to employ the **Metaplan technique** (we started doing that on 10.06.2005) to allow for a structured and well-documented discussion.
